

# PIXEL-ART

This game invites you to observe images more closely.

The next 3 STEPS allow you to play several games and to zoom into the details of paintings.

Suggestion: go step by step

STEP 1: Reconstruct the image  
To play alone or with a partner

STEP 2: Reconstruct the pixelated image  
To play alone or with a partner

STEP 3: Finding matching pairs  
To play against another player or team

## TIP

When facedown, the text "Pixel-Art" on the back of any card reminds you which way is up on the face of the card.




## STEP 1

Take the first set of 16 cards  
Recreate the squared image (4x4 cards)

Keep in mind:

The image in each square is a reference for the reconstruction of the whole.

Each card has a grid on it, and by column or row, no grid is the same.



## 1st PUZZLE


## STEP 2

Keep the square you just made with the first 16 cards, and take the second set of cards.

Create a square grid similarly to that in Step 1.

The grids of coloured squares correspond to the abstract version of the original image.

Tip: Recreate the pixelated image by placing the second set on top of the previous one
